The name Moonlight Sonata was not coined by Beethoven himself, but instead by the German music critic, Ludwig Rellstab in 1836. Rellstab wrote that the sonata had reminded him of the reflected moonlight off of Lake Lucerne, hence the Moonlight Sonata became the unofficial, moreover a permanent title of the piece (The History of ...

Piano Sonata No. 14 in C-sharp Minor, nicknamed as "Moonlight Sonata", is a solo piano piece in sonata form, composed by Ludwig van Beethoven. The reason it was nicknamed as the 'Moonlight Sonata' is due to its traces to the 1830s when the German Romantic poet Ludwig Rellstab had published a review. It was stated that the first movement of the piece illustrated a boat floating about in the moonlight on Switzerland's Lake Lucerne.

The Piano Sonata No. 31 in A \flat major, Op. 110, by Ludwig van Beethoven was composed in 1821. It is the central piano sonata in the group of three, Opp. 109-111, which he wrote between 1820 and 1822, and the thirty-first of his published piano sonatas. The work is in three movements. The moderate first movement in sonata form, marked con amabilità, is followed by a fast scherzo. The finale comprises a slow recitative and arioso dolente, a fugue, a return of the arioso lament, and a second ...

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Beethoven revolutionarily modifies the sonata form, transforming it into a multi-stage drama through the innovative motivic development indicated above and, as a result, through ambiguity of formal functions of almost all the sections of the sonata form.
