Erosive tooth wear is the third most common dental condition, after caries and periodontal disease. Typically, it affects up to 30% of European adults aged 18 to 30 years old. Of which about 3% have severe levels that could justify restorative intervention.

Tooth wear is majorly the result of three processes; attrition, abrasion and erosion. These forms of tooth wear can further lead to a condition known as abfraction, where by tooth tissue is 'fractured' due to stress lesions caused by extrinsic forces on the enamel.

How to diagnose tooth erosion. Your patient's diet or dietary habits may increase their risk of erosive tooth wear. 3,6 Ask them the following questions to help determine their risk: How many times do

you consume acidic foods or drinks in a day? Do you have a history of gastric reflux? Do you swish or hold acidic drinks in your mouth?

A suitable index for classification of ETW is the basic erosive wear examination (BEWE). Regarding the etiology, patient-related factors include the predisposition to erosion, reflux, vomiting, drinking and eating habits, as well as medications and dietary supplements.

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
