The department of nursing or patient care services should establish a program for nursing orientation, yearly competency review of high-risk low-frequency therapies, core competencies based on patient population, and an ongoing educational program specific for pediatric critical care nursing. Pediatric intensive care units are often busy, crowded, over stimulating, short staffed, procedure oriented, and hectic. Until recently, parents were often asked to leave the room or unit during procedures, report, and rounds. Visits for older siblings were limited to short periods of time, if allowed at all.

The general pediatric care unit provides nursing care to children with a wide range of acute and chronic medical and surgical conditions. Children who require more frequent and invasive monitoring such as those with severe, critical, or life-threatening conditions are cared for in the pediatric intensive care unit (PICU) where the staff has advanced knowledge and training in the care of critically ill children.
