#### **Overview of Landlord-Tenant Laws in Colorado | Nolo**

State laws specify when and how a landlord may terminate a tenancy. For example, a landlord may give a Colorado tenant who has repeatedly violated any lease clause an unconditional quit notice that forces the tenant to move out immediately. If the tenant does not leave, the landlord can file for eviction.

Tenancy at sufferance: A tenant who has no right to occupy the premises, but is tolerated by the landlord and may be ter-

minated at the will of the landlord. Payment of rent by the tenant transforms the tenancy into an “at will” tenancy. Tenancy for year to year: A written lease with a term of at least one year. If there is no expiration ...
