We recommend trees are planted about 2 metres apart, but you can plant them 1-5 metres apart depending on your space and plan. Wavy lines look more natural than regimented rows of trees. If you're planting a single hedge, place your trees 30cm apart. For a thick hedge, plant a double row of trees in a zig zag pattern.
