VCOP - four aspects of writing which the Big Writing approach focuses upon - vocabulary, connectives, openers, punctuation. Vocabulary - use "wow" words ie interesting and ambitious words. "Nice" is boring and could be replaced by fantastic, amazing, delicious, etc. Connectives - includes conjunctions, ie joining words between two phrases, eg so, and, but, because, that, however, in addition to, etc.

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A quick word of caution: emphasise the importance of applying ambitious vocabulary thoughtfully. For example, it is perfectly acceptable to use 'said' as a speaking verb in dialogue; alternatives should be used where it adds something for the reader but overuse of them can be distracting or even annoying.

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VCOP Writing Vocabulary, Connectives, Openers and ...

Each letter of VCOP stands for an aspect of writing that will help them improve all writing in every subject. V = Vocabulary (the words they use in their writing) We call them WOW words! For example: instead of using the word 'nice', we could other more interesting words such as 'beautiful, stunning, fantastic' etc.

VCOP - Vocabulary, Connectives, Openers and Punctuation ...

Connectives connect and relate sentences and paragraphs. They assist in the logical flow of ideas as they signal the relationship between sentences and paragraphs. In prose, the material is supported and conditioned not only by the ordering of the material (its position) but by connectives which signal order, relationship and movement.
